**PORT OF MELBOURNE  
SOUTH WHARF 27 AND 28 STAGE 2 REFURBISHMENT WORKS AND WHARF CLOSURE**

**Date:** 11 January 2019

**Refers:** NTM 322 (T) / 2018 and is hereby cancelled.

**Details:** Port users are advised that South Wharf 27 and 28 stage 1 refurbishment works are complete. Stage 2 works will commence on Wednesday 16 January 2019 and continue until approximately Wednesday 6 March 2019. Works will take place between the chainage marks, 000 to 220 metres and will include installing sheet piles new fenders and concrete slabs on the wharf deck.

Works will be carried out by Fitzgerald Constructions Australia, during day light hours, 6 days a week (Monday to Saturday). Works will take place at the wharf face from The JUPB and Barge 12 (see pictures below).

Due to the works, South Wharf 27 and 28 will be closed to shipping from 22 January 2019 until approximately 6 March 2019.
