PILING WORKS WEST OF YARRA RIVER CHANNEL BEACON NO. 47- EXTENDED

Date: 28 May 2019

Refers: **NTM 117 (T) – 2019 refers and is hereby cancelled.**

Details: Mariners are advised that piling works at Fisherman's Bend to the west of Yarra River Beacon Number 47 is now extended until approximately Wednesday 5 June 2019. Piling works will be coordinated around shipping during daylight hours.

Works will be conducted using the following plants;

- Pile driving barge 162 (18.3 x 7.6m)
- Assisting Work Barge 176 (20.3 x 8.7m)
- Work Boat Wizard (5.0 x 2.1m)
- Tug Lady Dashedelle (7.6 x 4.0m)

The barge will be moored by a single anchor extending approximately 64 metres into the Yarra River Channel. The anchor will be marked with yellow special markers. Anchor will be recovered for large vessel movements and will be removed at the completion of work each day.

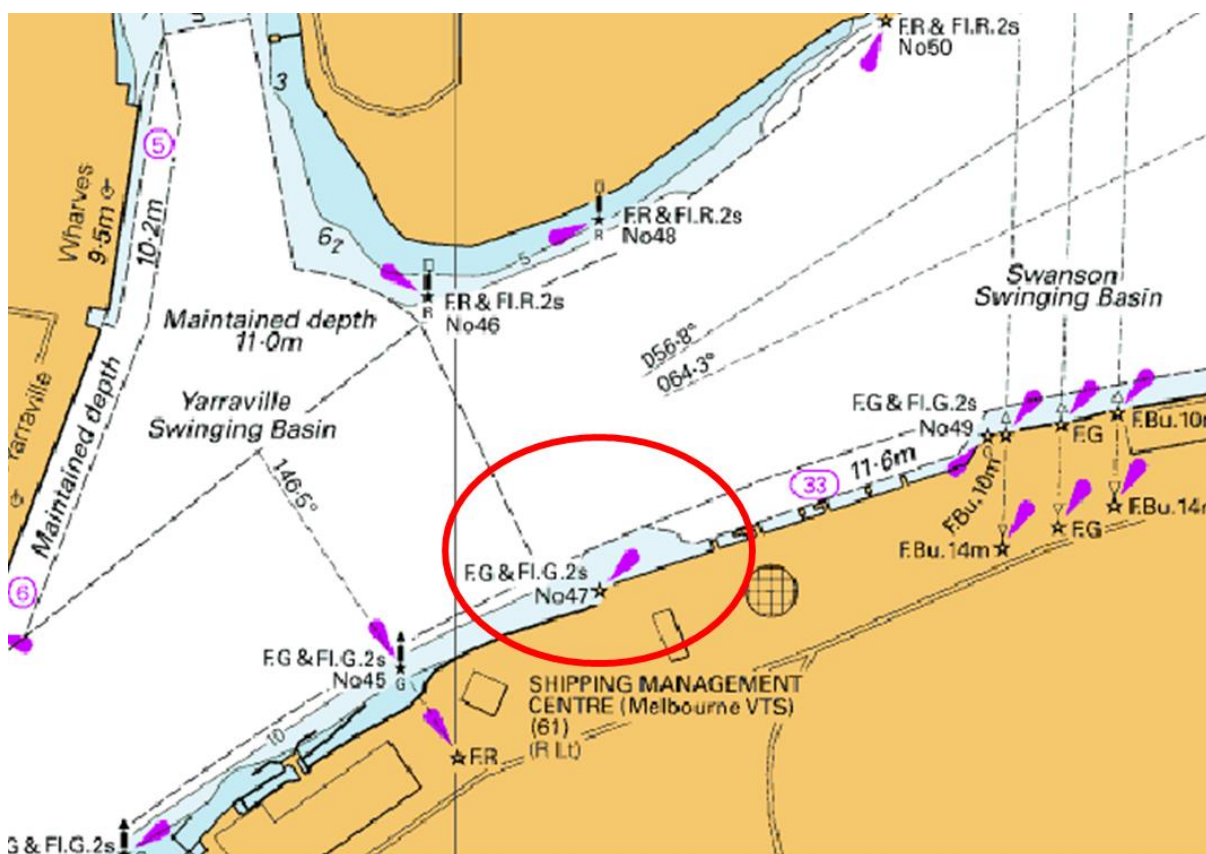
