

Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Australia – Victoria No. 077 (T) of 2019 Bass Strait – Golden Beach

Date: FROM 6 APRIL 2019

Details:

Mariners are advised of diving operations being undertaken south of Golden Beach within 3NM from the coast, at location 38.15.432177' S to 147. 25.307525' E (see attached map). There will be a red unlit surface buoy situated at the centre of the dive site location. The area covered will be approx. 2nm east and 2nm west of this location.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the buoy and the vessel 'SECA' MSV 11730 (call sign "SECA") which will be displaying code flag "A" (diver) and day shape "restricted in ability to manouver" (See attachment).

Mariners should keep a minimum distance of 100 metres from vessel "SECA" and slow to a speed of 5 knots when passing, mariners should also keep a listening watch to VHF Channel 16.

The diving operations will commence on Saturday 6 April 2019 and continue for approximately 6 days.

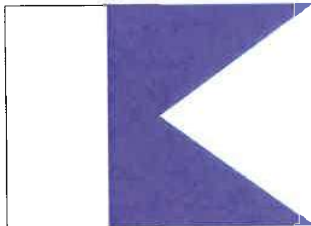
