FIREWORKS DISPLAY / PORT OF GEELONG WATERS

Date: Effective Wednesday 19 June 2019 between 2030 – 2100 hours

Details: Mariners are advised of a fireworks display between the Royal Geelong Yacht Club and Cunningham Pier during the times noted above. There is a set aside for the fireworks display that extends in a 100m radius from approximate location: 38°8.443'S, 144°21.938'E (WGS84). This set aside area is put in place to ensure public safety in the port as per WorkSafe requirements, delineating the safety fallout areas for this fireworks display.

The set aside has been established under Section 232 (1) of the *Marine Safety Act (Vic)* 2010. Entry is prohibited to all persons excluding the event participants and designated safety craft.

Mariners are prohibited from entering the exclusion zone during the date and times nominated above and are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the declared exclusion zone.
