West of St Kilda Marina – Deployment of Water Quality Monitoring Station

Date: Immediate

Details: Mariners are advised that a water quality monitoring station has been deployed west of St Kilda Marina at approximate location: 37°52.480'S, 144°56.310'E (WGS84).

The water quality monitoring station is marked by a yellow special buoy with the following characteristics: FLY.2.5s. The monitoring station will remain in place for approximately 2 years.

Mariners should navigate with caution around the monitoring station.
