PORT OF BARWON HEADS

ORUNGAL WRECK HAZARD

EAST OF RIVER ENTRANCE

Date: With immediate effect.

Details: Mariners are advised that there is a hazard to the safe navigation of Bass Strait near the mouth of the Barwon River, approximately 800 metres east of Point Flinders.

Four boiler remains of the wreck of the coastal trading vessel The Orungal are variably awash at low tide.

This wreckage over about 50metres is approximately centred at 38° 17' 14.82" South and 144° 30' 36.96" East (WGS 84)

Mariners are advised to exercise caution when navigating in the area.
