The following Victorian Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Victorian NTM 199 - Western Port

Sand waves in main shipping channel

Effective 22 August 2019

Details: Sand wave shoals extend up to 100m into the shipping channel between buoy 13 and buoy 15.
Least depth of main shoal 13.6m.
Approximate position of least depth 38° 25.5'S 145° 13.8'E

Sand wave shoals extend up to 50m into the shipping channel between buoy 19 and buoy 21.
Least depth of main shoal 13.2m.
Approximate position of least depth 38° 22.8'S 145° 14.7'E

Sand wave shoals extend up to 40m into the shipping channel between buoy 21 and buoy 23.
Least depth of main shoal 13.5m.
Approximate position of least depth 38° 21.9'S 145° 14.4'E



Sand wave shoals extend up to 10m into the shipping channel between buoy 22 and buoy 24.

Least depth of main shoal 13.8m.

Approximate position of least depth 38° 22.1'S 145° 14.3'E

Vessels with drafts of over 12.0 m must exercise caution when navigating in the vicinity of these shoals
