



VICTORIAN NOTICE TO MARINERS

Port of Geelong No. 02 - 2020

BED-LEVELLING/SWEEPING OPERATIONS

Date: Effective Monday 06 January 2020

Details: Mariners are advised that bed-levelling and sweeping operations are scheduled to commence on or about 06 January 2020 and continue for approximately three weeks.

The works will be conducted by Tug EDI, a 24m twin screw utility vessel. The vessel will be operating in various locations within the berths, and channels within port of Geelong waters. The hours of operation will be variable during the period.

The vessel will exhibit shapes and lights in accordance with the Prevention of Collisions at Sea Regulations 1972, and will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 12.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the Port of Geelong, proceed at a safe speed at all times and keep well clear of the above operations at all times.

This Notice will remain in force until 31 January 2020
