As a result of the upgrades to Webb Dock 4 East and 5 East, vessels with a displacement greater than 118,000 t but less than or equal to 140,000 t can berth with a berthing speed of 0.11m/s and the use of a Docking Aid (PPU) approved by the Harbour Master.

Pilots will be required to ensure that their (PPU) units are approved by the Harbour Master and that the berthing speed does not exceed 0.11m/s
