

Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Australia – Victoria

No. 361 (T) of 2020

BASS STRAIT – LORNE & AIREYS INLET

Date: EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

Details:

Mariners are advised of two special buoys established in the positions (below) to mark Fish Aggregation Devices (FAD). One FAD will be anchored approximately 3.75 nautical miles east of Lorne and the other FAD will be anchored approximately 4 nautical miles south east of Aireys Inlet. Each special buoy is 1.26 metres high and 800 mm in diameter and displays flashing yellow lights as detailed below.

| 6 | 38° 32.264' S 144° 01.940' E | Fl Y 5s 2-3 NM |
| 7 | 38° 29.143' S 144° 09.728' E | Fl Y 5s 2-3 NM |
