**SEDIMENT SAMPLE COLLECTION AND DEPLOYMENT OF AWAC
TURBIDITY AND LIGHT SENSORS PORT MELBOURNE SPOIL GROUND - AMENDED**

Date: 29 December 2020

Notice NtM 349 (T) / 2020 is hereby cancelled.

Details: Mariners are advised that the deployment of an Acoustic Wave and Current (AWAC) station, turbidity and light sensors in the Port Melbourne Spoil Ground (Northern Dredge Management Ground) deployed on 21 December 2020, the position of the the "Turbidity + Light" is amended.

The AWAC, turbidity and light sensors were deployed in the following locations:

AWAC + Turbidity +Light	38° 00.828'S	144° 52.677'E
Turbidity +Light	37° 58.745'S	144° 53.475'E
Light	38° 01.742'S	144° 52.499'E
Light	38° 01.040'S	144° 52.902'E
Light	38° 01.650'S	144° 51.676'E

The AWAC will remain in place for approximately 6 weeks prior to relocations. The AWAC will extend approximately 1.5 metres above the sea floor.
