VICTORIA DOCK 24 – KEEP CLEAR FOR HEAVY LIFT VESSEL

‘STELLAPRIMA’ DOUBLE BANKING WITH TRANSHIPMENT VESSEL ‘SEVEN EAGLE’

Date: 20 January 2021

Details: Mariners are advised the Heavy Lift Vessel “*Stellaprima*” is scheduled to arrive Victoria Dock 24 to double bank alongside the “Seven Eagle” on or about 20 January 2021.

There will be double banking operations during the period of 20 Jan 2021 and 30 March 2021. Mariners are advised to keep clear whilst these vessels are double banked and transhipment operations are in progress. Authorised vessels working in proximity of the operations excepted.

The Heavy Lift vessel ‘*Stellaprima*’ will also lower its pontoon in the water whilst alongside, at night the pontoons will be illuminated by flood lights from the vessel and the pontoon extremities will be lit by yellow flashing lights.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the Victoria Dock 24 and shall reduce speed having due regard to the safety of the operation.
