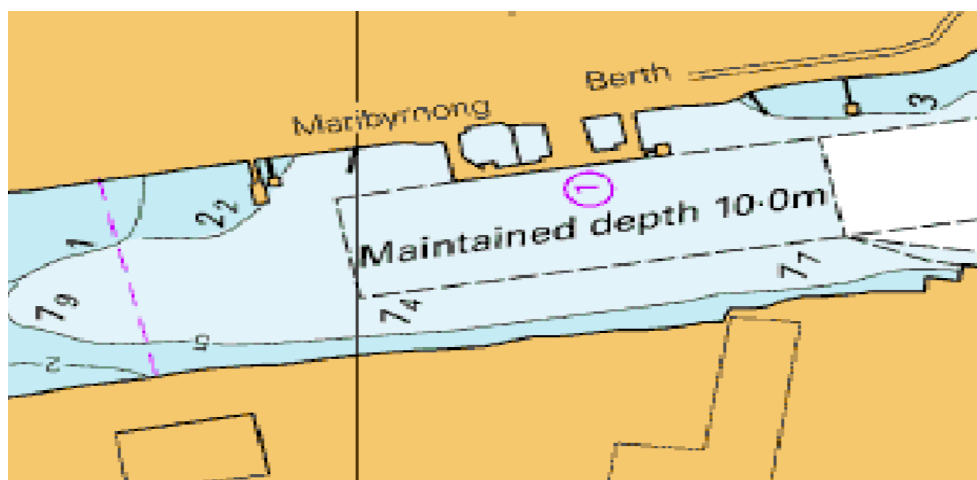
MARIBYRNONG 1 BERTH POCKET - REDUCTION IN DEPTH

Details: Mariners are advised that a reduction in depth has been Identified in the berth pocket of Maribyrnong 1.

The maximum maintained depth of 10.00 m has been reduced to 9.80m. All vessels berthing at Maribyrnong with a draft of greater than 9.20m will have to apply for an Overdraft Permit.
