The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information

Australia – Victoria No. 140 (T) – 2021 PORT OF MELBOURNE CHANGES TO COASTAL VESSELS INFORMATION IN HARBOUR MASTER'S DIRECTIONS

Date: 21 May 2021

Reference: Harbour Master's Directions (HMD) Edition 11 May 2019

Details: The conditions for coastal vessels passing other vessels at the Heads as detailed at HMD Section 3.13.1 are currently under review.

Mariners are advised that this notice temporarily amends Harbour Master's Directions Section 3.13.1 - specifically the table on Page 34 for named coastal vessels passing certain other vessels in the Fairway at Port Phillip Heads.

Until further notice, in addition to the conditions detailed at 3.13.1, such passing shall only occur in daylight hours and with a tidal stream of 3 knots or less.

The contents of Section 3.13.1 otherwise remain unchanged.
