Details: Mariners are advised that an inspection of the Hobsons Bay Main Sewer protection plates, between Yarra River Beacons 33/34 and 35/36 will take place from Friday 04 June until approximately Friday 25 June 2021.

The inspection works will involve diving and will take place around shipping, managed by VPCM VTS.

Works will be conducted from the following boats:

- *MV Pro Diver, MV Alice and MV Venture.*

Vessels transiting the Yarra River in the vicinity of the services protection, during diving operations must reduce vessel speed so as to create no wash and pass the dive vessel at a safe distance.

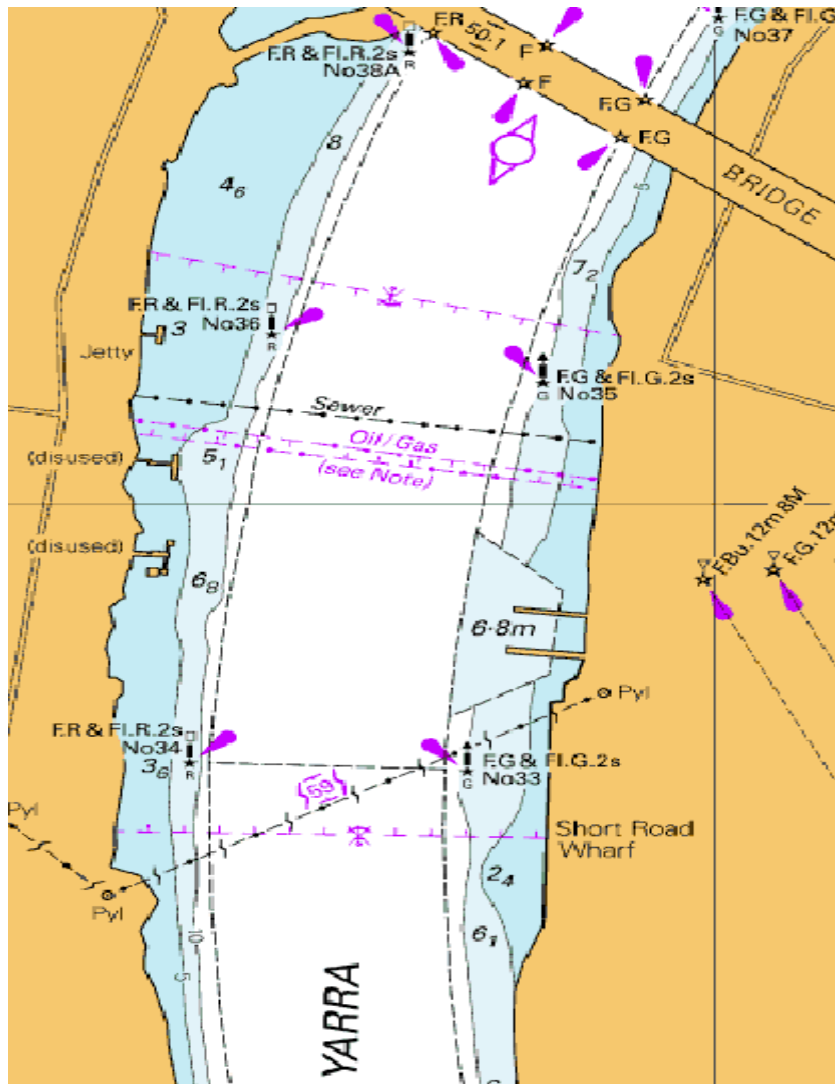
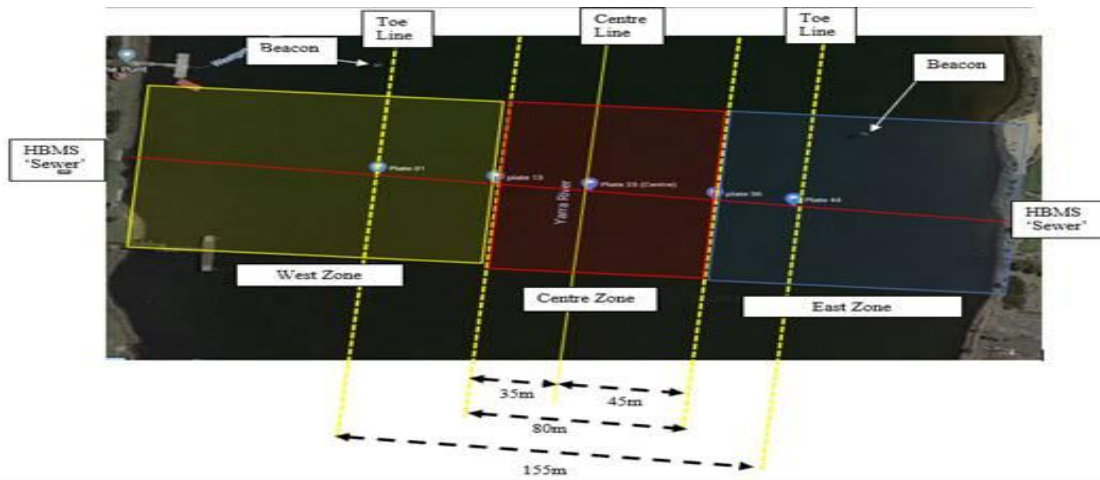
Mariners are advised to navigate with additional caution and reduce speed so as to create no vessel wash when in the vicinity of the works at the services protection.
