Dive boat 'Valerie May', barge 'Jack Daniels and support vessels 'Pindar' and 'Mundu' will be deploy in support of these operations and can be contacted on VHF channels 12 or 16 as required.

A five knot speed limit applies to vessel operators and water skiers within a distance of 100 m of a vessel, buoy or structure on which a 'diver below' signal is displayed.
