



## VICTORIAN NOTICE TO MARINERS

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

**Australia- Victoria**

**No. 292(T) of 2021**

**LOCAL PORT OF PORTLAND BAY**

**DATE:** COMMENCED APPROX. WEDNESDAY 16<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2021.

**DETAILS:** Mariners are advised of a new wave buoy mooring deployed within the Local Port of Portland Bay. (Location- see appendix 1)

**The wave buoy is located at 38°.20'51.54", 141°36'37.8".**

The wave buoy will measure wave height, wind speed and surface temperature. The 3-buoy floating structure will consist of a solar powered yellow buoy, 42 cm wide and 31 cm high (see appendix 2). Attached to these buoys will be two 250 mm orange surface floats (see appendix 3). The Yellow buoy will display a flashing amber light for night visibility.

Mariners are to be aware when sailing, fishing, and boating in the area.

The expected duration of the deployments is ongoing.

This area is also covered by a special mark as displayed in appendix 3.
