

# Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

**Melbourne, 17 November 2021**

**Australia – Victoria**

**Local Port of Port Phillip**

**Brighton**

**Brighton Harbour – Fairway Maintenance Dredging Works**

**Date: Immediate**

**Details:** Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works along the fairway within Brighton Harbour, at approximate location 37°54.408'S, 144°58.933'E (WGS84). The fairway will remain open, but access may be restricted from time to time during these works.

A cutter suction dredge will remove sand from the fairway between the marina pontoons and the western point of the cusped spit. A submerged pipeline will transport sand to a near shore disposal site north east of the harbour.

On-water plant, equipment and potential hazards to navigation arising from the works will be marked as per IALA standards.

**Mariners are reminded that the dredge is restricted in its ability to manoeuvre and that all day shapes or nav lights must be obeyed. Navigate with caution within the vicinity of the works.**
