

Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Australia – Victoria No. 389 (T) of 2021 BASS STRAIT – LORNE & AIREYS INLET

Date: EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

Details:

Notice to Mariners No.361 (Temporary) of 2020 is referred and cancelled.

Mariners are advised that two special buoys have been re-established in positions (refer locations below) to mark Fish Aggregation Devices (FADs). One buoy is located approximately 3 nautical miles east of Lorne and the other buoy is approximately 3.2 nautical miles south east of Aireys Inlet.

Each special buoy is 1.26 metres high and 800mm in diameter and displays a yellow flashing light as detailed below.
