### PORT MELBOURNE CHANNEL BEACON 6 REPLACEMENT

**Date:** 17 December 2021

**Refers:** Na

**Details:** Mariners are advised that piling operations at Port Melbourne Channel Beacon 6 in position 37° 54.5' S 144° 55.6' E will occur between 20 December 2021 during daylight hours subject to weather and expected to be completed on or about 22 December 2021.

A temporary red light flashing every 2 seconds (Fl.R.2s) will be fitted on the existing beacon 6. The temporary light will be put in place at the end of each day until the works are complete.

The following vessels will be in attendance to support installation works:

- Shine – Transport of Ladder
- MV LOBO – Crew transfer
- DSV Matilda Mae – Dive support vessel
- Taree – Crane Supply Barge
- JUB II – Jack up Barge / Piling Barge
- Taurus – Assist Tug

Mariners are advised that during piling operations, a 100m no wake temporary exclusion zone will be established in position 37° 54.5' S 144° 55.6'E. Authorised vessels of the operations are excepted.

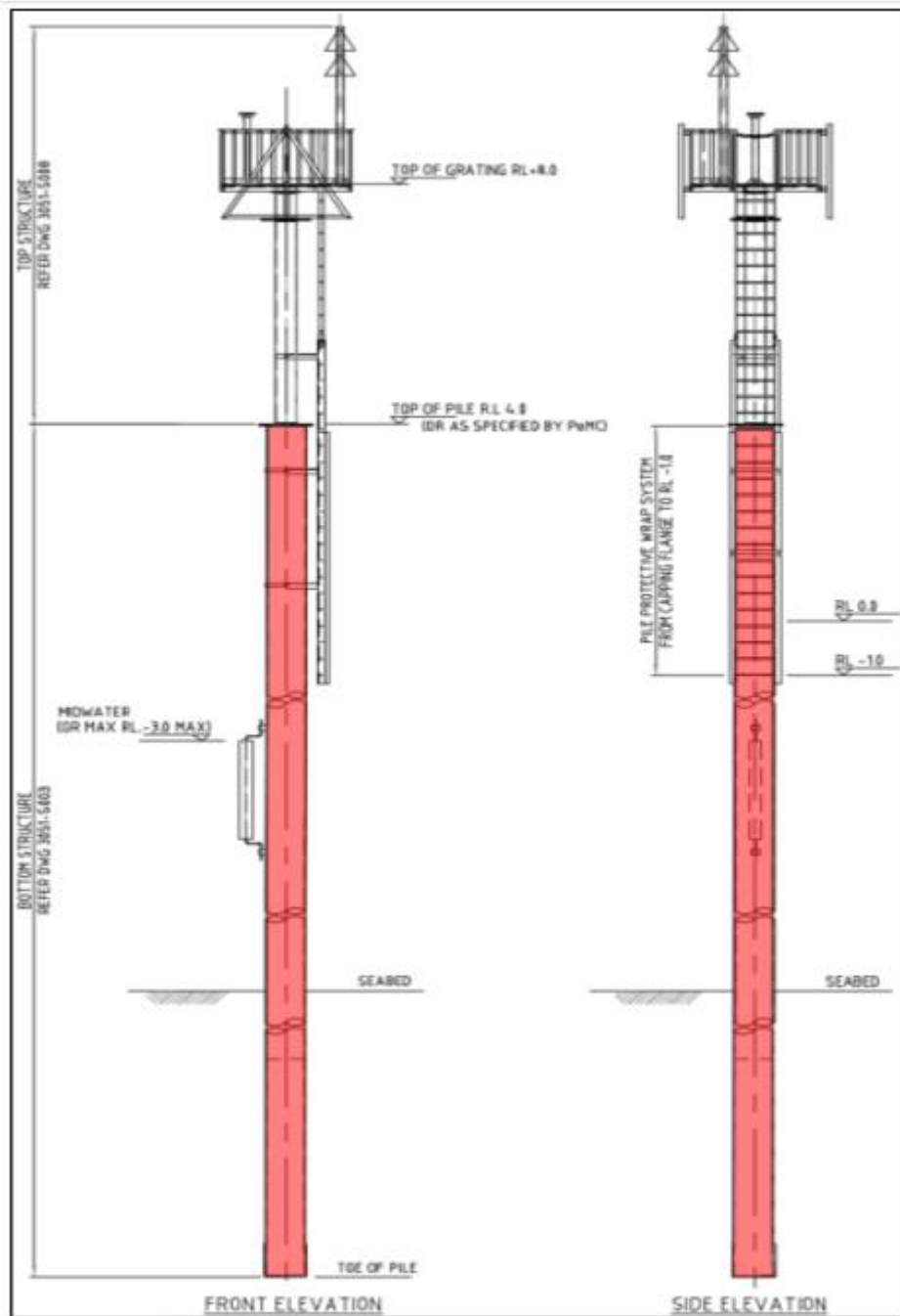

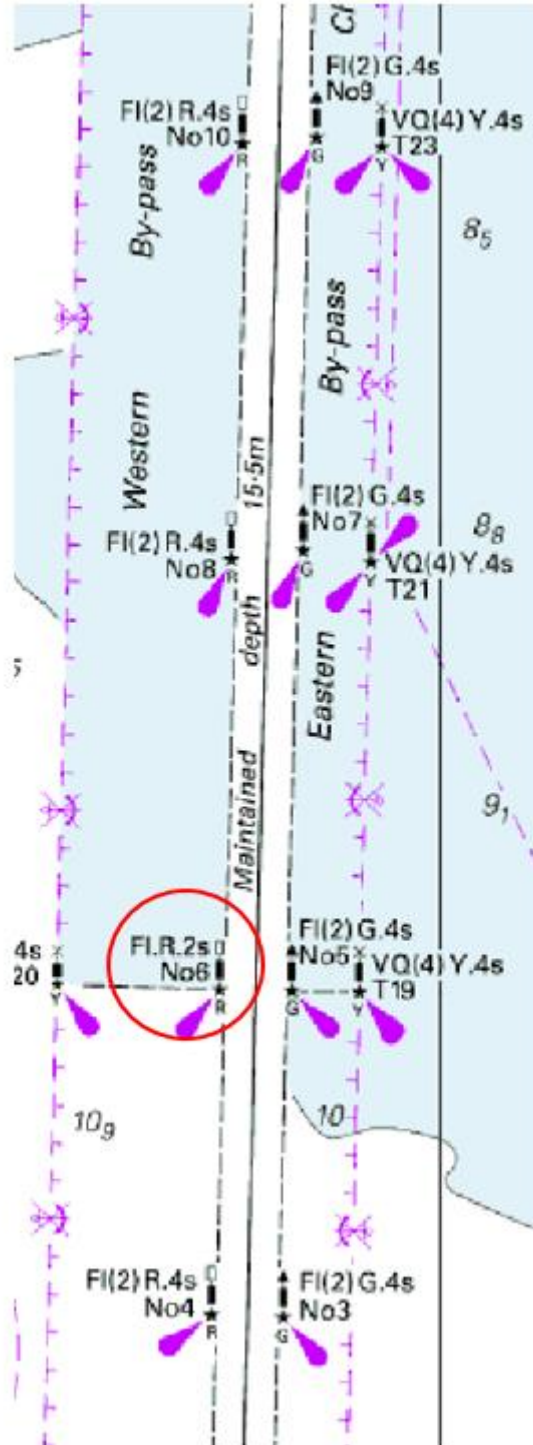
