**Williamstown Mooring Ground – Sunken Vessel**

**Date:** Immediate

**Details:** Mariners are advised that a vessel has sunk on its mooring on the eastern side of Williamstown Mooring Ground, at approximate location 37° 51.373'S, 144° 54.551'E (WGS84).

A portion of the vessel may be visible above the water line, and a lit yellow buoy with characteristics Fl.Y.3s has been attached.

The vessel will be salvaged as soon as practicable.

**Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the Williamstown Mooring Ground.**
