PORT MELBOURNE CHANNEL BEACON 1 TEMPORARY BUOY
IN PLACE**

Date: 11 March 2022

Refers: NtM 087 (T) / 2022 and is hereby cancelled.

Details: Mariners are advised that Port Melbourne Channel Beacon 1 has broken, and the residual pile is protruding 8 metres above the seabed in vicinity of 37° 55.6' S 144° 55.7' E.

A temporary starboard hand buoy with light characteristics Fl(2)G 4s has been positioned 20m west from the pile toe. Virtual AIS ATON TB8 remains active in position of the hazard.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the Port Melbourne Channel Bcn 1.

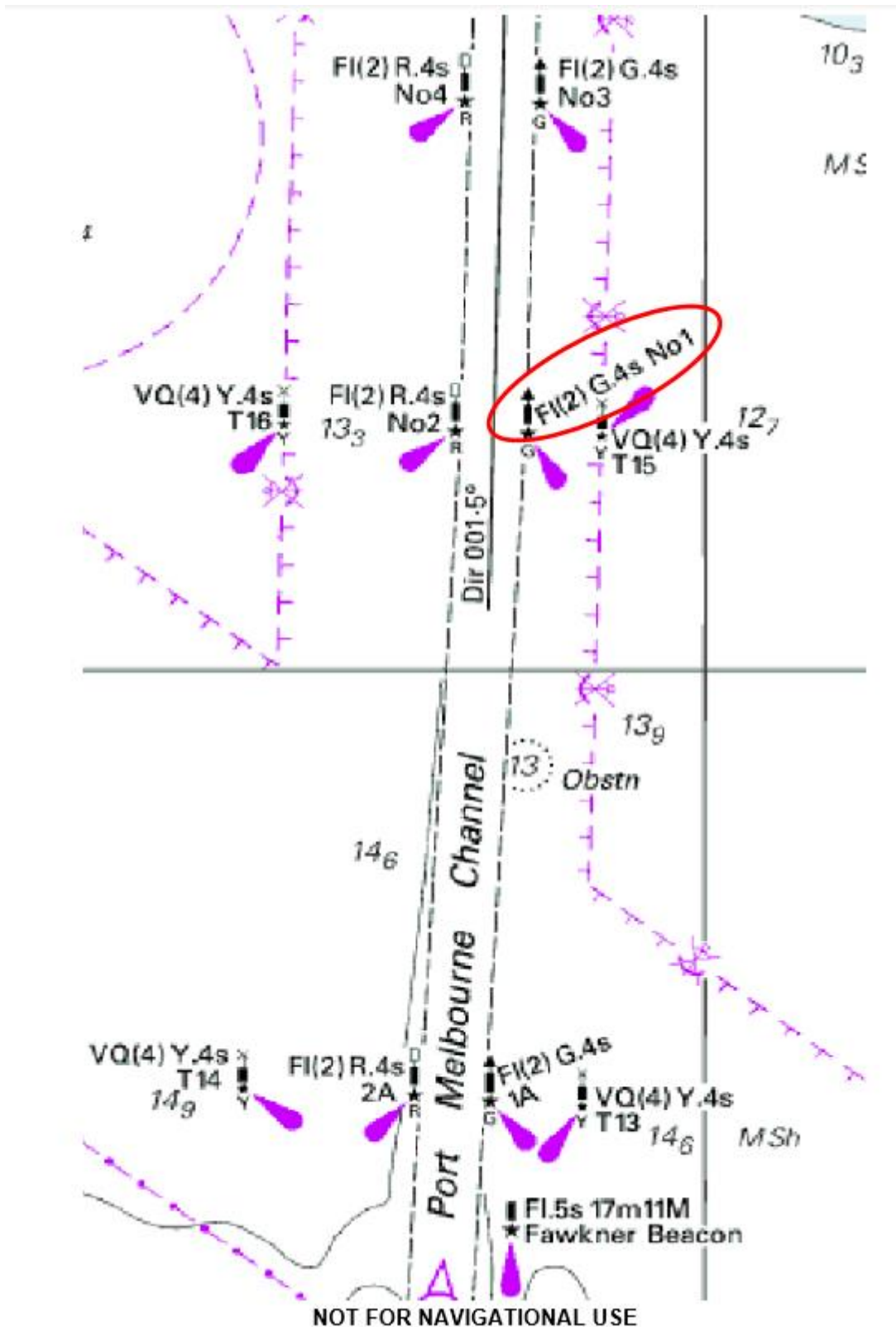
