**Dredging for Beach Renourishment Works** 

Date: Immediate

**Details:** Mariners are advised of dredging works for beach renourishment undertaken by

the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning (DELWP) at Tootgarook,

at approximate location (WGS84): 38°21.900'S, 144°51.000'E.

Dredging works will be carried out by a cutter suction dredge operating in an area

approximately offshore from Tootgarook Beach. Dredged material will be

transported via pipeline and deposited on Tootgarook Beach.

The Pipeline, On-water plant, equipment, and potential hazards to navigation

arising from the works will be marked as per IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the works.
