Details: Mariners are advised that demolition works of Dolphins BD1 and reconstruction of mooring dolphins BD2 and BD3 will be carried out on the Gellibrand Pier berth pocket, the works will take place from 26 April until approximately 14 May 2022. During this period the berth will remain closed to all commercial traffic. The demolition works will be carried out by Fitzgerald who can be contacted on 0430 017 779.

The following plant will be in use for the demolition works.

- Self-Elevating Platform (SEP) barge *Fuji*
- Service barge L147
- Workboats *Stay Calm* and *Taurus*

The service barge L147 when not in use will be berthed at Break water Pier.

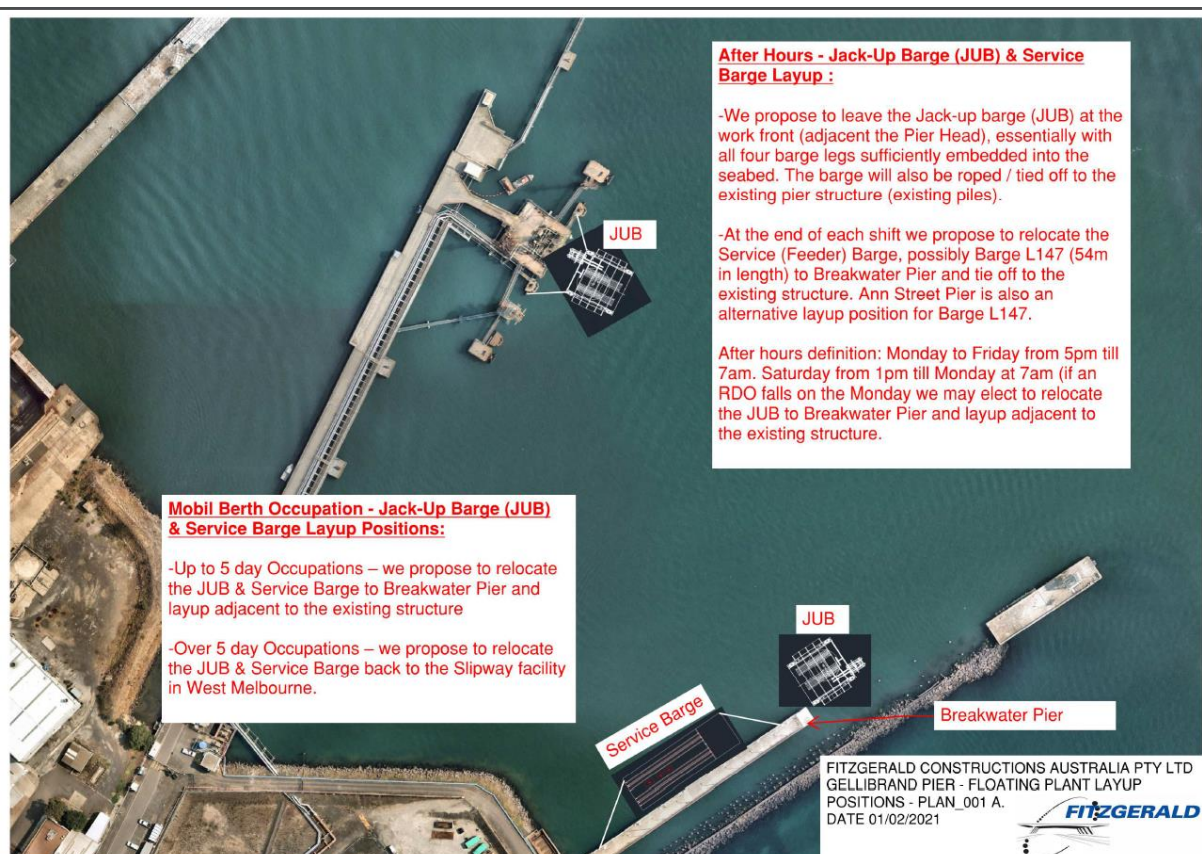
