

Details:	Mariners are advised that surveys in the South Channel have identified areas of shoaling which are marked by a virtual buoy in the following location:
	Identification message – TB5
	Established in position - 38° 19 .054S, 144° 48.633E
	The virtual buoy TB5 has been established to mark the current shoaling depth of 15m. Deep draught vessels with a draught greater than 13.5m are advised to pass south of TB5.
	Mariners on deep draught vessels are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the virtual buoy.


