CLOSURE OF YARRA AND MARIBYRNONG RIVERS TO COMMERCIAL  
TRAFFIC - COMPLETED**

**Date:** 15 October 2022

**Refers:** **NTM 347 (T) – 2022 refers and is hereby cancelled.**

**Details:** The closure of the Yarra and Maribyrnong Rivers to commercial vessels due to flooding events has now been lifted and the rivers are now open to commercial vessels, subject to ongoing assessments and controls by the Harbour Master.

There is still debris floating downriver and freshwater current effects are being observed. Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in these areas and report any sightings of debris to Melbourne VTS.
