**Details:** Mariners are advised that sweeping works will take place from 24 October 2022 for approximately 5 days until 29 October 2022.

Sweeping works will take place at the following locations:

- Maribyrnong and Yarraville berth pockets and adjacent areas

Sweeping works will be conducted during daylight hours only from 0600 to 1800 around shipping by sweep tug **Molly Grace** (LOA 29.00, Beam 9.00m).

The works will be supported by the survey vessel **John Norgate**.

Vessels involved in sweeping works will be monitoring VHF Channel 68 and 12.

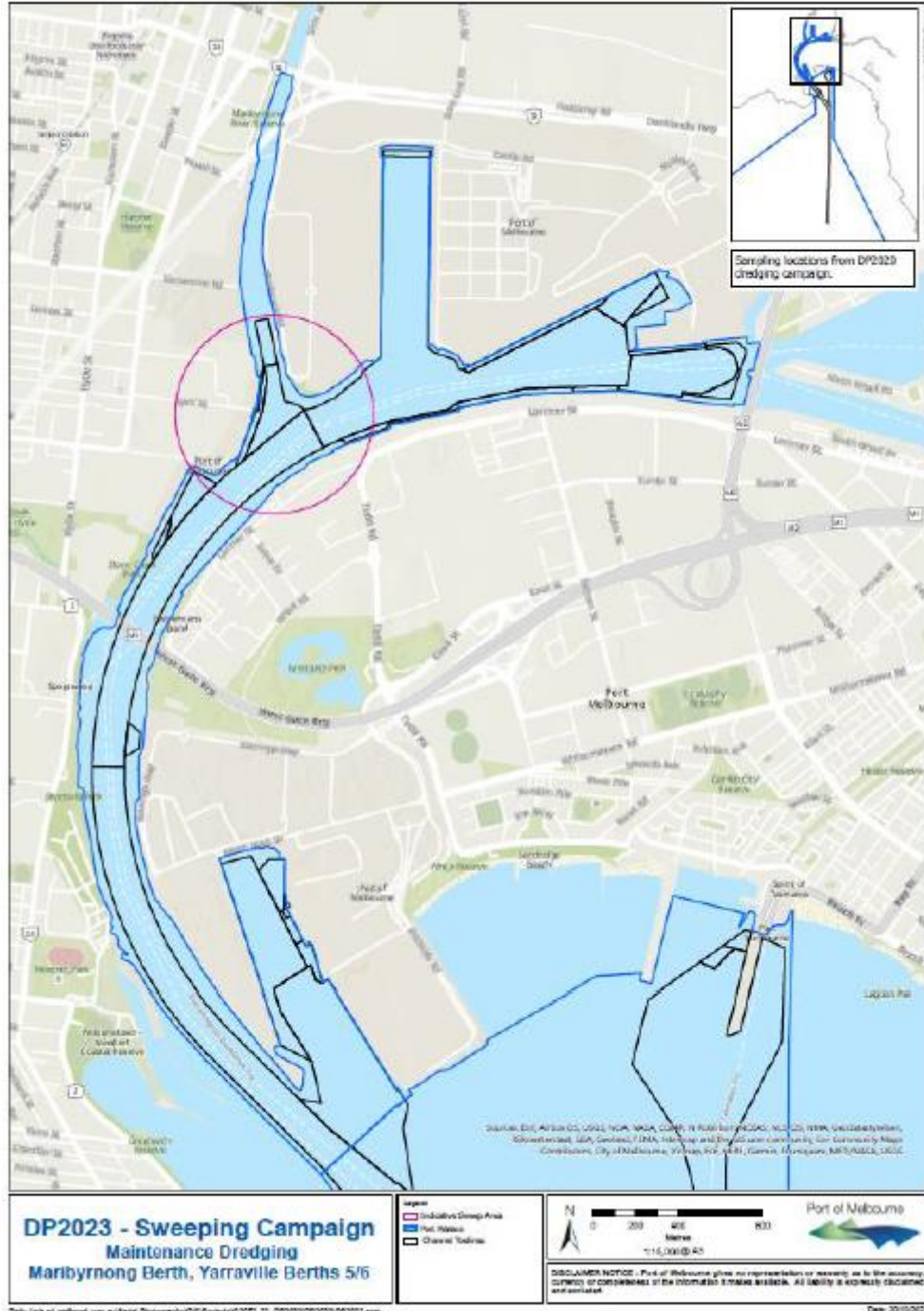
