No vessel is permitted to berth at Maribyrnong No. 1 berth during the above closure period.

Sweeping works will be conducted during daylight hours only from 0600 to 1800 around shipping by sweep tug **Molly Grace** (LOA 29.00, Beam 9.00m).

The works will be supported by the survey vessel **John Norgate**.

Vessels involved in sweeping works will be monitoring VHF Channel 68 and 12.
