## YARRAVILLE 5 AND 6 BERTH CLOSURE - SWEEPING WORKS

**Date:** 27 October 2022**Refers:** NtM 363 (T) / 2022**Details:** Mariners are advised that Yarraville 5 and 6 berths will be closed for sweeping works from **0830 on 27 October 2022 until further notice.**

No vessel is permitted to berth at Yarraville 5 and 6 berths during the above closure period.

Sweeping works will be conducted during daylight hours only from 0600 to 1800 around shipping by sweep tug **Molly Grace** (LOA 29.00, Beam 9.00m).

The works will be supported by the survey vessel **John Norgate**.

Vessels involved in sweeping works will be monitoring VHF Channel 68 and 12.
