Details: Mariners are advised that a recovery operation for a fouled anchor at A3

Anchorage area is planned for Thursday 24 November 2022

commencing at approximately 0730.

The recovery operation will include diving works and the following vessels:

- 1. *MEDUSA* (dive vessel)
- 2. DANGERFIELD (crane vessel)

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution and reduce vessel speed so as to create minimum vessel wash when in the vicinity of the A3 Anchorage area.

A3 Anchorage remains unavailable for anchoring until further notice.
