**Details:** Mariners are advised of a submerged obstruction (fender) that exists in the immediate vicinity of the wharf face at Inner East Station Pier.

A temporary yellow buoy has been established in position **37° 50.595' S, 144° 55.928' E** to mark the position of the submerged obstruction.
