Details: Mariners and port users are advised that further wharf repair works will take

place at Webb Dock 5 East starting from **0600 hrs on Friday 3 March**

until 1800 hrs on Friday 3 March 2023.

The repair works will be conducted around shipping between chainage marks 600m and 630m. Vessels will berth no further south of chainage

mark 540m during repair works.
