The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information

Australia – Victoria No. 346 (T) - 2023 PORT OF MELBOURNE PORT MELBOURNE CHANNEL-SOUTH BEACON 8 OFF STATION

Date:	20 August 2023

Refers: NtM 345 (T) – 23 and is hereby cancelled.

Details: Mariners are advised that Port Melbourne Channel-South Beacon 8 located in position 37° 53.856' S 144° 55.577' E is off station.

The beacon is lying on the seafloor immediately to the northeast of its charted position. The beacon presents an obstruction as follows:

- Beacon 8 charted position: least depth of 8.6m
- Beacon 8 extremity to the northeast: least depth of 13.4m

A virtual aid to navigation **TB12** is established at the northeast extremity of the beacon in the following position: **37° 53.850' S 144° 55.588' E**

A port hand lateral mark buoy has been deployed directly to the north of the fallen beacon position, details as follows:




