PORT OF MELBOURNE MARIBYRNONG RIVER WEST GATE TUNNEL PROJECT CONSTRUCTION WORKS

Date: 31 August 2023

Refers: NtM 387 (T) - 2022 and is hereby cancelled.
NtM 217 (T) - 2020 and is hereby cancelled.

Details: Mariners and port users are advised that construction works for the West Gate Tunnel Project on the Maribyrnong River to the north of Maribyrnong No. 1 Berth extending to Shepherd Bridge, is now extended until **31 August 2024**.

Mariners are advised that the Maribyrnong River will be subject to full and partial closures between Shepherds Bridge and Youell Street during this period.

Here attached Government Gazette Notice – **No. G 34 - 24 August 2023 - West Gate Tunnel Project Maribyrnong River closures**.

Works are being conducted from **Monday 0600hrs through to Sunday 0500hrs**. The works will include piling and construction of three bridges crossing the river.

The construction zone is delineated with booms and yellow special mark buoys fitted with quick flashing yellow lights as per attached traffic management plan diagrams.

Works are being conducted using the following vessels:

- Jack Up Barge 2 (18 x 22m), serviced by Pontoon L147
- Jack Up Barge 3 (18 x 22m)
- Jack Up Barge 4 (18 x 22m)
- MV Stay Calm
- MV Lady Dashedelle
- MV Mayas Bay
- MV Walrus
- Tender vessel Phoenix
- Tender vessel Workboat 020

Vessel operators shall reduce vessel speed to create no wash and remain clear of the construction zone area.

During partial river closures, works standby vessels will guide river traffic through the transit lane as required.

Mariners are advised to navigate with additional caution in the vicinity of the construction works.

NOTICE CONTROLLING NAVIGATION IN THE VICINITY OF WORKS

I, David Tilsley, Deputy Harbour Master – port of Melbourne, as authorised delegate of Ports Victoria, the port management body for the port waters of the Port of Melbourne, make the following notice under section 211(1)(b)(i) of the **Marine Safety Act 2010** for the purposes of the works activity proposed by West Gate Tunnel Project to undertake bridge construction works.

The navigation and movement of vessels is restricted and/or prohibited from waters of the Maribyrnong River as detailed below in Table 1, excluding vessels involved in the works and emergency response vessels.

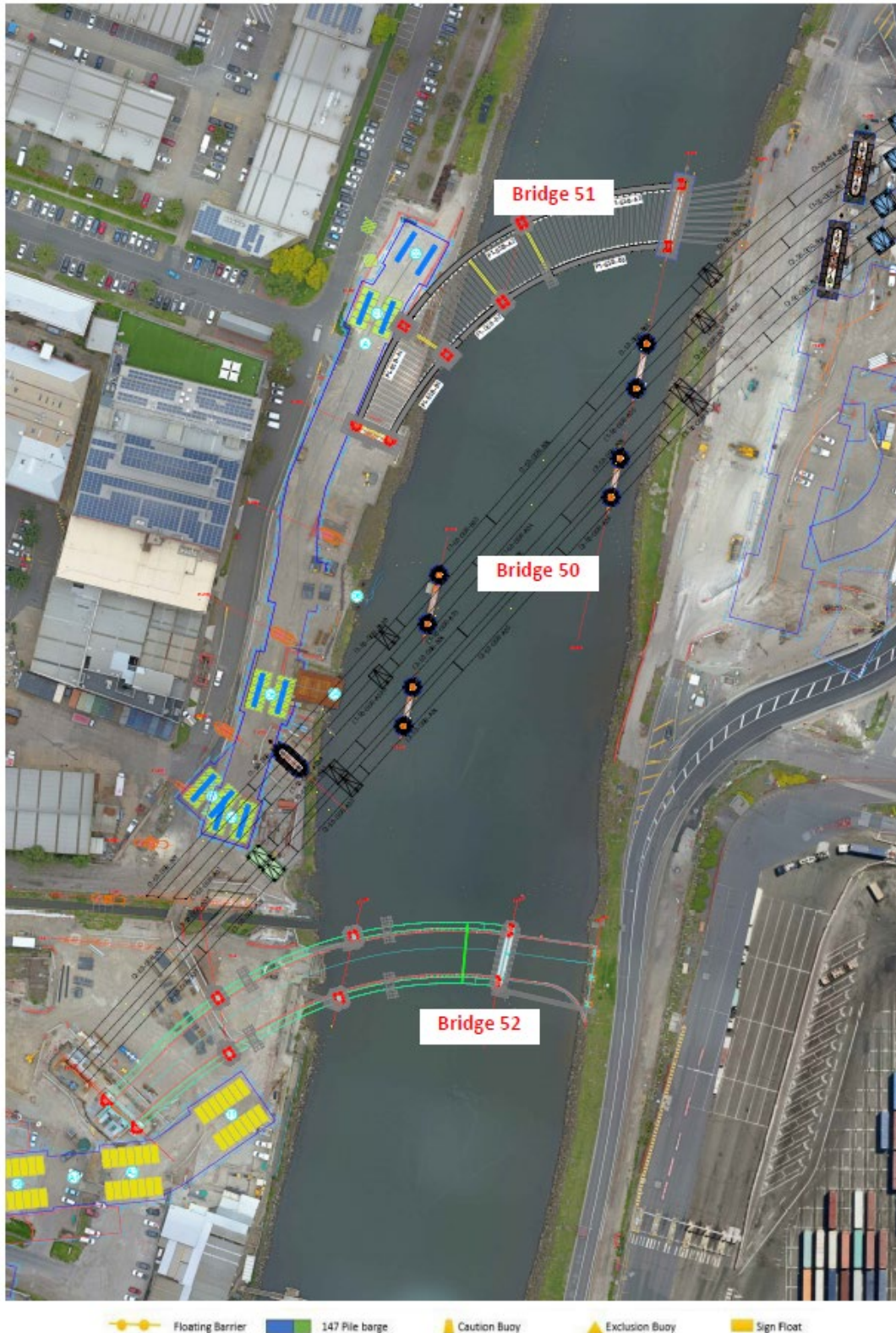

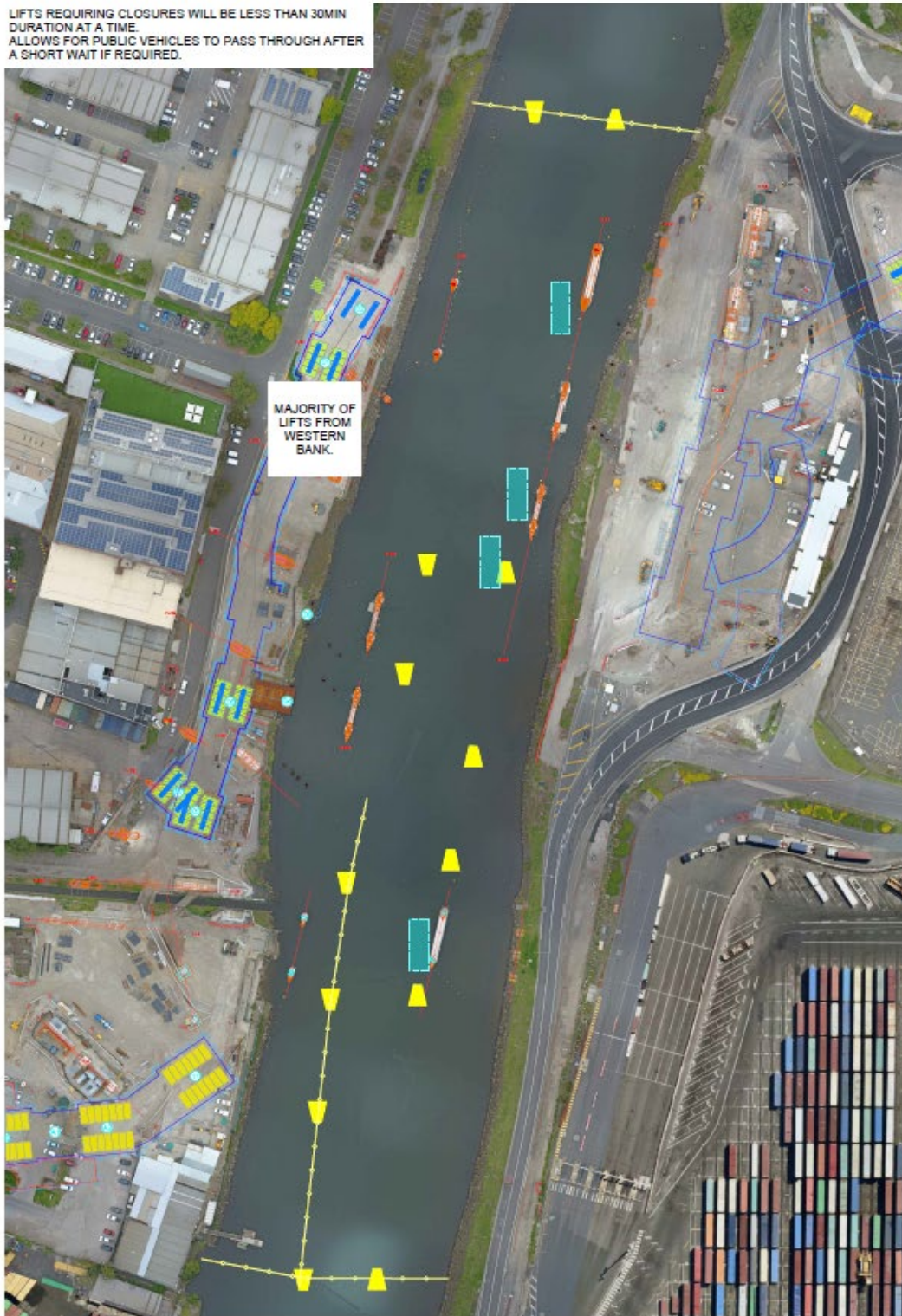
Typical Partial Closure of River
