PORT OF MELBOURNE WEBB DOCK 4 EAST PORTAINER CRANE BOOMS

Date: 15 September 2023

Refers: NtM 370 (T) – 2023 and is hereby cancelled.

Details: Mariners and port users are advised the vessel *Hua Hai Long* (LOA: 182m /

Beam: 43.6m), berthed starboard side alongside at **Webb Dock 4 East**, has 2 Portainer cranes onboard with booms in the lowered position that extend beyond

the berth pocket.

An air draught clearance survey and measurements of boom extension have been conducted with results as follows:

 Distance from Webb Dock 4 East wharf face to outer reach of crane booms: 114.9m

- Distance from waterline to the underside of the booms is approximately 58.29m (subject to ballast conditions onboard vessel)

The Portainer crane booms have anti-collision lighting on the boom tip and top of the pylon/a-frame.

Air draughts of all vessels must be declared to Melbourne VTS prior to arrival and departure from Webb Dock.

Air draughts of vessels arriving and departing Webb Dock are not to exceed 48m.

Mariners are advised to navigate with additional caution in the vicinity of Webb Dock 4 East berth.


