Details: Mariners and port users are hereby advised of the forthcoming edition of **Harbour Master's Directions – Melbourne Edition 13.1, September 2023**. This preliminary Notice to Mariners provides a 7 days' notice period preceding Edition 13.1 taking effect.

Mariners will be advised on **29 September 2023** through a Notice to Mariners that Harbour Master's Directions – Melbourne Edition 13, September 2022 will be withdrawn and replaced by **Harbour Master's Directions – Melbourne Edition 13.1, September 2023**.

A separate Notice to Mariners will be promulgated on 29 September 2023 providing consolidated tables of maintained depths for berth pockets, channel reaches, swing basins and least depths for anchorages. Any future changes to depths in port waters will be promulgated by Notice to Mariners with updated tables of maintained and least depths.
