Details: Mariners and port users are advised that walkway replacement works will be conducted at **Gellibrand Pier Inner Dolphin No.4** with plant equipment extending into the Gellibrand Pier berth pocket.

Works are expected to be conducted on **31 October and 01 November 2023**.

Walkway replacement works will be supported by the following vessels:

- **Ando**
- **Crane / Rhumb Barge**
- **Oversea**
- **Wizard**

Restrictions for passing vessels during works:

- **Minimum wake and wash**
- **Minimum passing distance of 50m**

Works will take place around shipping movements.

Mariners are advised to navigate with additional caution in the vicinity of Gellibrand Pier.

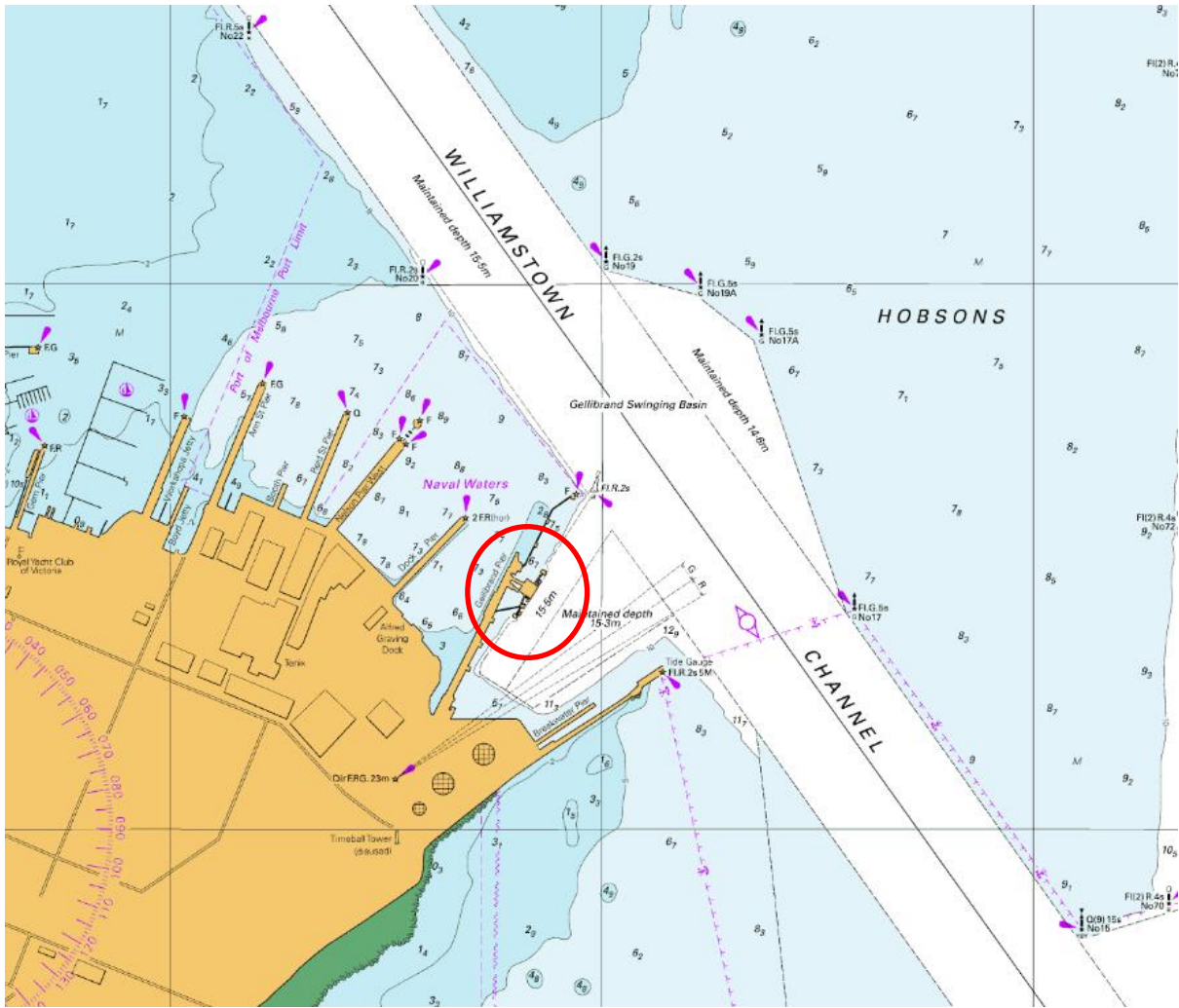

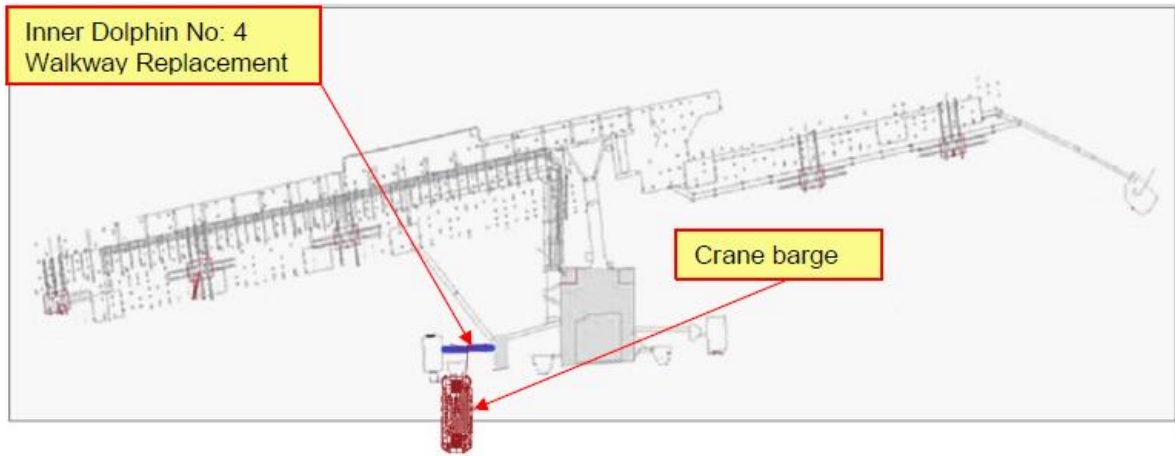
