PORT OF MELBOURNE APPLETON F BERTH PILE REMEDIATION WORKS

Details: Mariners and port users are advised that pile remediation works involving diving operations will take place at Appleton F berth from **16 October to 27 October 2023**.

The works will be conducted around shipping outside the berth occupancy from **0700 hrs to 1800 hrs**.

Pile remediation works will involve shore side and under wharf repairs. Bhagwan Marine will conduct diving operations during the remediation works and utilise the following vessels for works:

- *Lobo*
- *Franjo*

International code flag Alpha will be exhibited during diving operations.

A minimum vessel passing distance of 50m will be in force during the works period. Minimum wake and wash to be observed by passing vessels at the minimum vessel passing distance.

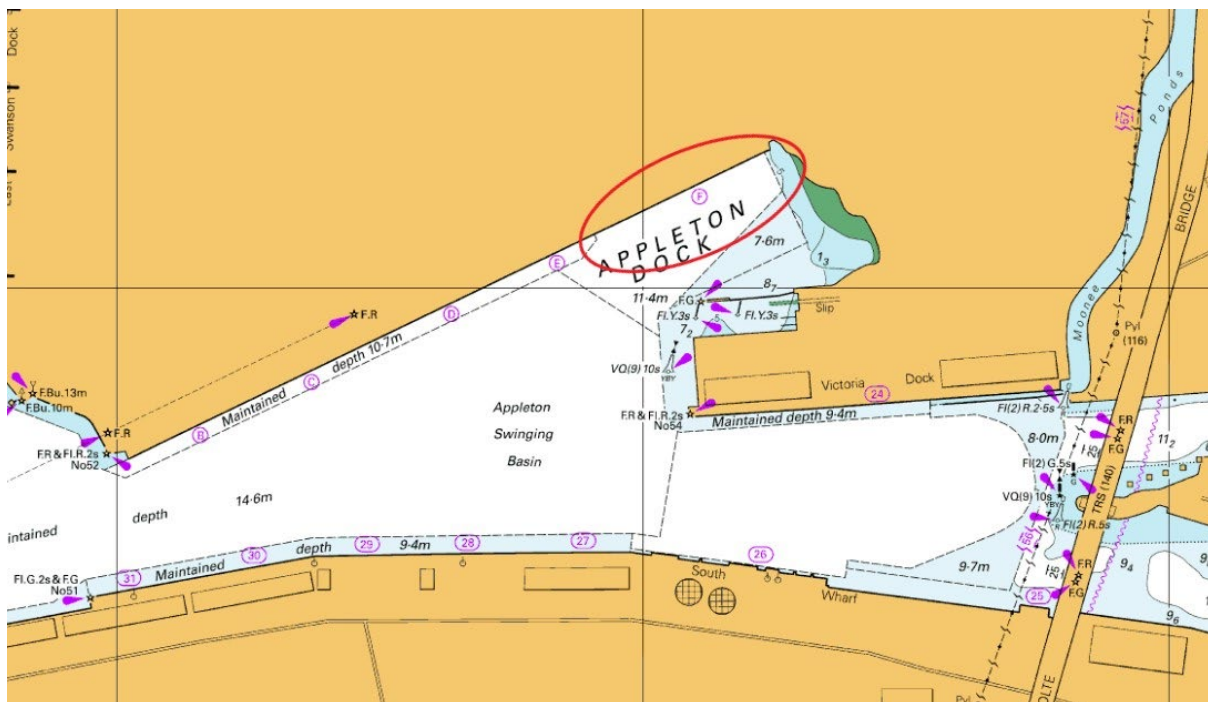
