
Australia – Victoria No. 420 (T) - 2023 PORT OF MELBOURNE STATION PIER INNER EAST FENDER WORKS

Details:	Mariners and port users are advised that fender works conducted at <b>Station Pier</b> Inner East, between chainage <b>240m and 480m</b> , have been extended.
	Works that include diving activities are expected to be conducted from <b>18</b> October to approximately <b>1</b> November <b>2023</b> .
