Details: Mariners and port users are advised that fender works conducted at **Station Pier Inner East** between chainage **240m and 480m** has been extended.

Works including diving activities are expected to be conducted from **02 November until approximately 30 November 2023** around shipping.

Fender works will be supported by the following vessels:

- ***MV Franjo DSV***
- ***MV First Class DSV***
- ***MV Lobo DSV***

Restrictions for passing vessels during works:

- ***Minimum wake and wash***
- ***Minimum passing distance of 50m***

Vessels engaged in diving works will display International Code flag “Alpha” during diving operations.

The works supervisor can be contacted on 0467 939 829. Dive vessels can be contacted on VHF channel 12.

Mariners are advised to navigate with additional caution in the vicinity of Station Pier Inner East.

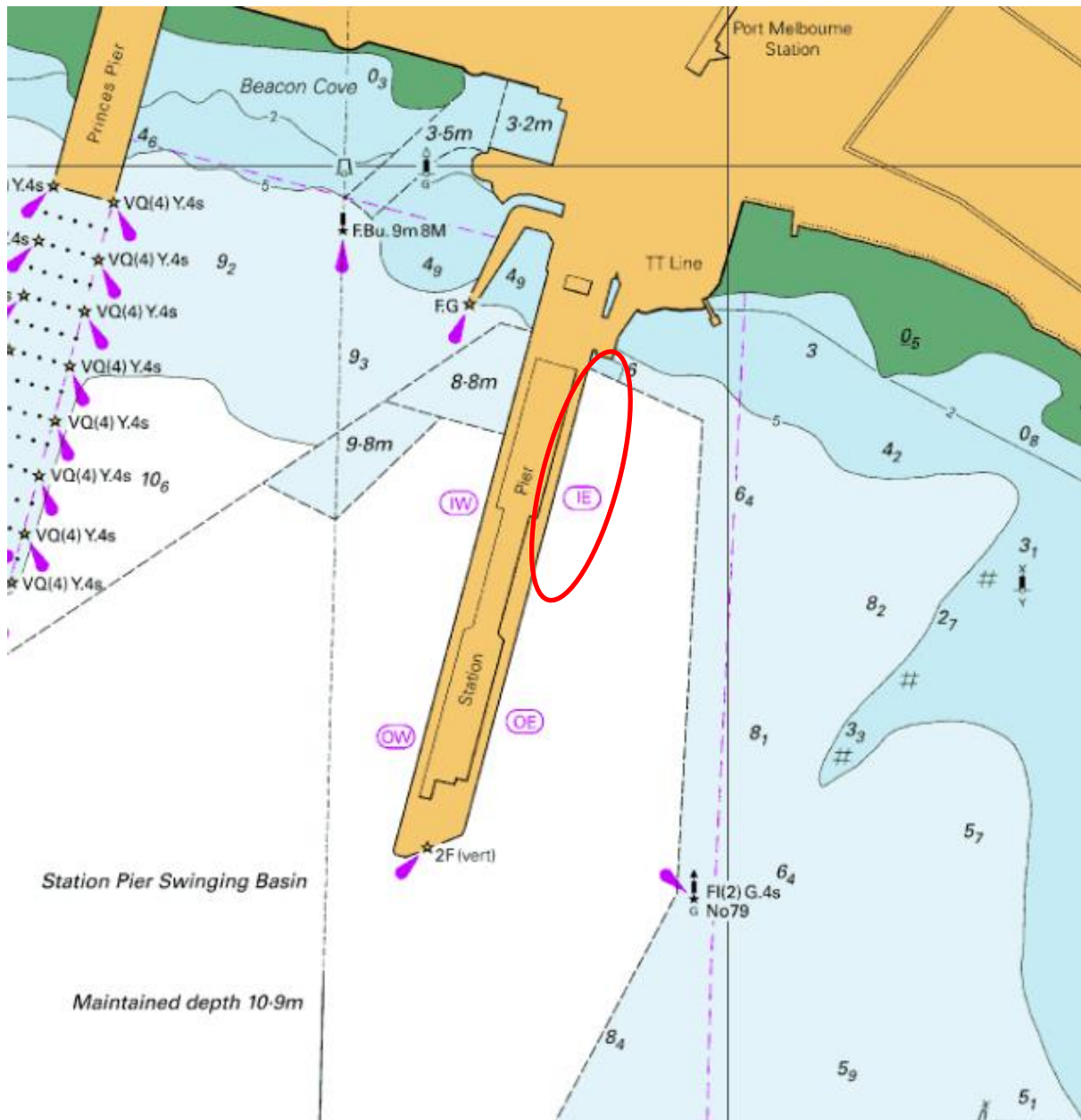
