The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information

Australia – Victoria No. 461 (T) - 2023 PORT OF MELBOURNE DREDGING WORKS

Date: 10 November 2023

Details:Mariners are advised that dredging works are expected to take place in the port
waters of the port of Melbourne from 15 November 2023 until approximately
21 December 2023.

Dredging works will take place at the following locations:

- Appleton Dock
- Swanson Dock
- Maribyrnong
- Short Road Wharf
- Webb Dock
- Station Pier

Works will be conducted by *Heron Construction Company* with dredging operations taking place 24 hours a day, 7 days per week during the campaign period.

The following vessels will be employed during the dredging works:

- GPK Backhoe Dredger
- PT Zarka Tug
- *H1201* Non-propelled split hopper barge
- H1202 Non-propelled split hopper barge
- CTV Investigator Support vessel
- John Norgate Survey vessel

Vessels engaged in dredging works will utilise VHF Channel 68 as a working channel and will monitor VHF Channels 12 and 16.

No channel closures will occur during dredging works.

All dredging works will be undertaken around shipping movements. Vessels engaged in dredging works will make way for transits of commercial vessels (SOLAS).

Domestic commercial vessels (DCV) operating sightseeing tours and recreational vessels must keep out of the way of vessels engaged in dredging works.


