Details: Mariners are advised that the **Webb Dock 3 East** demolition works, which include the removal of a redundant concrete structure (known as “the knuckle”), are now completed.

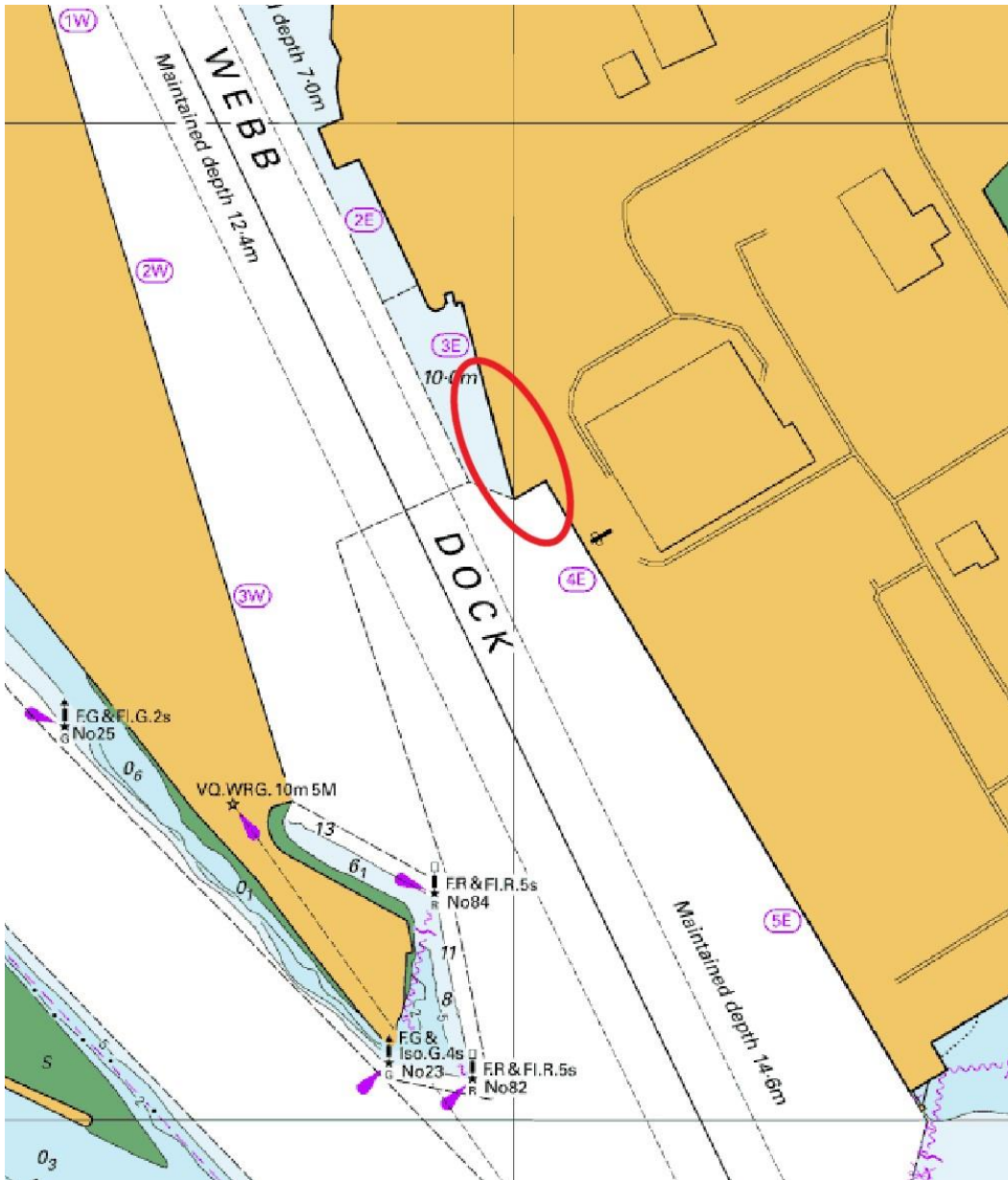
Webb Dock 4 East berth has been extended by **71m** as a result of the demolition works. The overall combined length of **Webb Dock 4 East** and **Webb Dock 5 East** is now **731m** (reference attached images).

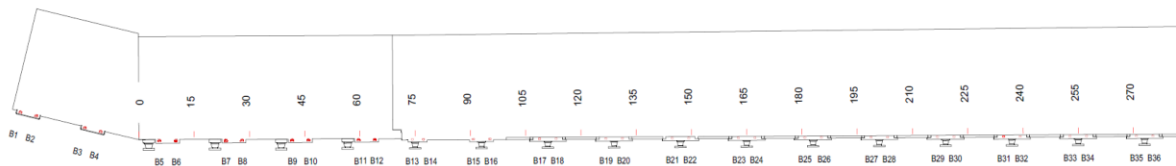
