Steampacket Quay – Floating Christmas Tree Barge Removed

Date: **Immediate**

Previous Notice: 430(T) – 23 is referred and cancelled.

Details: Mariners are advised that the temporary barge installation to support the Geelong Floating Christmas Tree, moored at Steampacket Quay at approximate location 38°08.598'S, 144°21.755'E (WGS84), adjacent to Cunningham Pier has been removed.

A submerged mooring anchor will remain in situ adjacent to Steampacket Quay in shallow water, as mentioned in NTM 262(T)-19.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of Steampacket Quay.
