**Details:** Mariners and port users are advised that pile rehabilitation works will take place at **Station Pier** from **26 March 2024 until approximately April 2024**. Works will be conducted at **Station Pier Outer West (OWSP) and Inner East (IESP)** berths.

Works, involving diving operations, will be conducted during **daylight hours** from **Monday to Friday** around shipping movements. The works supervisor can be contacted on **0400 220 126**.

The following vessels will be involved in the works:

- ***MV Eliza***
- ***MV Lobo***
- ***MV Matilda Mae***

Vessels engaged in diving operations will display International Code flag Alpha.

Restrictions for passing **domestic commercial vessels** and **recreational vessels** during **diving operations**:

- ***Minimum passing distance of 50m***
