Details: Mariners and port users are advised that pile rehabilitation works will take place at Station Pier from 26 March 2024 until approximately April 2024. Works will be conducted at Station Pier Outer West (OWSP) and Inner East (IESP) berths.

Works, involving diving operations, will be conducted during **daylight hours** from **Monday to Friday** around shipping movements. The works supervisor can be contacted on **0400 220 126**.

Vessels engaged in diving operations will display International Code flag Alpha.

Restrictions for passing **domestic commercial vessels** and **recreational vessels** during **diving operations**:

• Minimum passing distance of 50m
