Tootgarook – Temporary mooring ground – Established.

Date: Immediate, until further notice.

Details: Mariners are advised of temporary moorings being utilised by Port of Melbourne contractors at the following approximate locations (WGS84).

- 38° 20.39 S, 144° 50.59 E
- 38° 20.49 S, 144° 50.49 E
- 38° 20.46 S, 144° 51.12 E
- 38° 20.59 S, 144° 50.59 E

Port of Melbourne barges and work boats will be moored for approximately 12 weeks as part of beacon remediation works in the South Channel. All on-water plant, equipment and potential hazards to navigation arising from the works will be marked as per IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the mooring ground.
